Paper submitted must be original, previously unpublished and not under consideration for publication elsewhere. Text(s) should be in Times New Roman font and size is 12 point, line spacing 1.5. References should be given at the end of the paper. **The seminar proceedings language should be English Only.** Selection will be made purely on the quality of the article/papers by the Peer-Review Committee.

PUBLICATION

The Organizing Committee will publish selected paper in the book with ISBN Number from a reputed national or international publisher. **Abstract** should be between 250 – 300 words in one page with five key words maximum, within the midnight of **28th February 2025**. Full length paper and abstract should be submitted in latest **APA format**. The length of the full paper along with abstract has to be within 3000 words or 8 pages maximum. The abstract should be sent by e-mail to seminar@saldihacollege.ac.in in **MS-WORD (.docx)** format only on or before **28th February 2025**. And the full paper should be sent by above e-mail on or before **3rd March 2025**. After the seminar, each of the authors whose papers will be selected by the review committee must receive at least one copy (multiple copies are allowed), the price of which will be announced at the time of publication.
